Year 4 Spring 2 and Summer 1

In maths we will be learning about fractions and decimals. We will be focussing on equivalent fractions, fractions greater than one and conversion between fractions and decimals. Throughout Spring 2 and Summer 1 we will be learning our 6, 7 and 9 times tables.

Our topic for Spring 2 and Summer 1 is Europe. In Geography the children will be exploring the world map, looking at the different continents and researching the different countries in Europe. In D&T the children will get the opportunity to create their night light, linking to science and simple circuits.

In English we will be looking at the book 'Kensuke's Kingdom' and creating our own ending to the story. The children will be researching their chosen European country in Geography to then include this in their stories. During Summer 1, the children will get the opportunity to write their own persuasive text linking to Europe.
